item # 2. useless rolling pin made to order. every one slightly different.

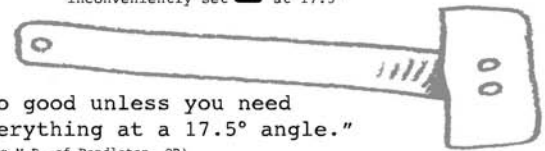

(says Mary of Medford, NJ)

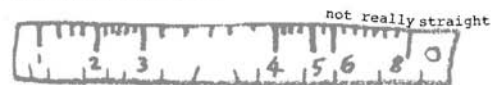
item # 4. useless rake made to order. every one slightly different.
